<u>Goonawarra Golf Club – Major Events Entry Policy</u>

Version 3 – dated 4 April 2025

Major Events (all Board Events)

The purpose of the policy is to clearly articulate the conditions of membership status, eligibility and competition entry for the Goonawarra Golf Club Major (Honour Board) event program. Therefore, providing clarity, transparency and avoidance of any inconsistency of understanding.

The Major Events are listed below:

- 1. Club Championship Men's
- 2. Club Championship Womens
- 3. Club Championship Junior
- 4. Foursomes- Men's
- 5. Foursomes- Women's
- 6. Foursomes- Mixed
- 7. Summer Cup
- 8. Winter Cup
- 9. Men's and or Medley 4BBB Matchplay
- 10. Women's or Medley 4BBB Matchplay
- 11. Medal of Medallists Men's & Women's
- 12. Midweek Medal of Medallist Men's & Women's
- 13. Midweek Championships Men's
- 14. Midweek Championships Women's
- 15. Midweek Championships Senior Men's

For all Major events listed numbers 1-11.

- To enter a Goonawarra Golf Club Major Event, all entrants must be financial 7 Day for Membership in the categories of the following: Lifetime Self-Funded/Pension, Honorary Life, Honorary Playing, Corporate, 7 Day, Pensioner, Self-Funded Retiree, Age 25-29, Age 21-24, Age 18-20 & Age 15-17 and Age 14 & under.
- Therefore, excluding Lifestyle, 6-day, 5-day (weekday) and social members.

For all Major events listed numbers 12-15.

- To enter a Goonawarra Golf Club Major Event, all entrants must be financial for Membership in the categories of the following: Lifetime Self-Funded/Pension, Honorary Life, Honorary Playing, Corporate, 7 Day, Pensioner, Self-Funded Retiree, 6-day, 5-day (weekday) Age 25-29, Age 21-24, Age 18-20 & Age 15-17 and Age 14 & under.
- Therefore, excluding Lifestyle and Social members.
- New Members must be financial for a period of 3 months, at Goonawarra Golf Club, prior to the commencement of the Major Event's first round.
- All players must have entered 12 rounds of golf within Golflink, with a minimum of 8 to have been played at Goonawarra Golf Club. These must be registered rounds within the directly preceding 12-month period to be eligible for major event entry.

- Unless otherwise indicated in the rules of competition, all players will use their Daily Handicap on the day of the competition. The Daily Handicap is derived from the Golf Australia Handicap posted in the Golf Link System.
- Each event has individual match and game policies which are listed on the individual conditions entry form, which must be followed per event.
- The required entry form and related conditions of entry must be completed and associated entry fee must get paid prior to commencement of the event or you will be deemed to not have entered.
- The Match Committee has the discretion to include and exclude any Member as it may deem necessary.
- Members within excluded membership categories can play in the daily event but will NOT be eligible to win any Major Events.
