



Goonawarra Golf Club – Major Events Entry Policy

Major Events (Honour Board)

The purpose of the policy is to clearly articulate the conditions of membership status, eligibility and competition entry for the Goonawarra Golf Club Major (Honour Board) event program. Therefore, providing clarity, transparency and avoidance of any inconsistency of understanding.

The Major Events are listed below:

1. Club Championship – Men's.
2. Club Championship – Women's
3. Club Championship – Junior
4. Foursomes- Men's
5. Foursomes- Women's
6. Foursomes- Mixed
7. Summer Cup
8. Winter Cup
9. Medley and or Men's 4BBB Matchplay
10. Medley and or Women's 4BBB Matchplay
11. Medal of Medallists - Men's & Women's (Including Medal Rounds)
12. Midweek Medal of Medallist - Men's & Women's (Including Medal Rounds)
13. Midweek Championships - Men's
14. Midweek Championships - Women's
15. Midweek Championships - Senior Men's
16. Manager's Trophy (Sunday Event)

For all Major events listed numbers **1- 11**.

- New Members must be financial for a period of 3 months, at Goonawarra Golf Club, prior to the commencement of the Major Event's first round.
- To enter a Goonawarra Golf Club Major Event, all entrants must be financial 7 Day for Membership in the categories of the following: Lifetime Self-Funded/Pension, Honorary Life, Honorary Playing, Corporate, 7 Day, Pensioner, Self-Funded Retiree, Age 25-29, Age 21-24, Age 18-20 & Age 15-17 and Age 14 & under.
(Therefore, excluding **Lifestyle, 6-day, 5-day (weekday)** and **social members**)
- All players must have entered a minimum of 12 rounds of golf within Golf Australia, with a minimum of 6 to have been played at Goonawarra Golf Club.
- A minimum of 6 rounds at Goonawarra Golf Club is in the preceding 12-month period to be eligible for major event entry. (9 hole rounds qualify).
- Each event has individual match and game policies which are listed on the individual conditions entry form, which must be followed per event.
- The required entry form and related conditions of entry must be completed and associated entry fee must be paid prior to commencement of the event or you will be deemed to not have entered.

For all Major events listed numbers **12- 15**.

- New Members must be financial for a period of 3 months, at Goonawarra Golf Club, prior to the commencement of the Major Event's first round.
- To enter a Goonawarra Golf Club Major Event, all entrants must be financial for Membership in the categories of the following: Lifetime Self-Funded/Pension, Honorary Life, Honorary Playing, Corporate, 7 Day, Pensioner, Self-Funded Retiree, 6-day, 5-day (weekday) Age 25-29, Age 21-24, Age 18-20 & Age 15-17 and Age 14 & under.
(Therefore, excluding **Lifestyle** and **Social** members)
- All players must have entered a minimum of 12 rounds of golf within Golf Australia, with a minimum of 6 to have been played at Goonawarra Golf Club.
- A minimum of 6 rounds at Goonawarra Golf Club is in the preceding 12-month period to be eligible for major event entry. (9 hole rounds qualify).
- Medal of Medal qualification requires the prior winning of a medal round as such all entry requirements in this policy also apply to Medal Rounds. A non qualifying player can still win the competition, but not the medal.
- Each event has individual match and game policies which are listed on the individual conditions entry form, which must be followed per event.
- The required entry form and related conditions of entry must be completed and associated entry fee must be paid prior to commencement of the event or you will be deemed to not have entered.

For Event **16** (Managers Trophy)

- To score points in Managers Trophy rounds entrants must be financial for Membership in the categories of the following: Lifetime Self-Funded/Pension, Honorary Life, Honorary Playing, Corporate, 7 Day, Pensioner, Self-Funded Retiree, 6-day, Age 25-29, Age 21-24, Age 18-20 & Age 15-17 and Age 14 & under. (Therefore, excluding **5-day**, **Lifestyle** and **Social** members).
- To score points in any round, players must have entered a minimum of 12 rounds of golf within Golf Australia, with a minimum of 6 to have been played at Goonawarra Golf Club.
- A minimum of 6 rounds at Goonawarra Golf Club is in the preceding 12-month period prior to the final round to be eligible for overall winner. (9 hole rounds qualify).
- Play in individual rounds and the payment of the daily entry fee enters players into the overall competition, subject to other conditions above.

All Major Events

- Unless otherwise indicated in the rules of competition, all players will use their Daily Handicap on the day of the competition. The Daily Handicap is derived from the Golf Australia Handicap system, posted on Golf.com.au
- The Match Committee has the discretion to include and exclude any Member as it may deem necessary.
Members within excluded membership categories can play in the daily event but will NOT be eligible to win any Major Events.
